
The kitchen is an entertainer's delight, with a large island and breakfast bar, creamy granite countertops, a farmhouse sink, high-end stainless steel appliances – and lots of counter and cabinet space. Step outside here to a balcony for grilling.











The balcony here has a retractable awning for shade, and you can watch the sun both rise and set from this space.





The bedrooms are all on the second level, and all are en suite. The primary suite has its own balcony overlooking the water and a walk-in closet large enough to accommodate a small office space. The laundry is also on this level.







The second two bedrooms open to yet another balcony facing north. The entry is on the lower level, with a clever Harry Potter space – and of course, an elevator that serves all three levels.







Charleston charm meets Key West funky; this home offers a high-end experience in a quirky, fun community. You're just a half block from the beach, and surrounded by independently owned shops, restaurants and bars, and access to nature.





Interior Details:

- Main living area is on the third floor to maximize water views
- Engineered hardwood floors throughout home
- Wet bar with ice maker, wine storage, clever "fish scale" blue tile backsplash
- Island kitchen with granite countertops, farmhouse sink, smooth surface range, microwave, stainless steel French door refrigerator with water & ice, tons of counter space and cabinetry, lighted display cabinetry, dramatic turquoise tiled backsplash, wide island breakfast bar
- Full bath with shower on the 3rd floor allows flexibility for guests and the potential to create an additional bedroom on this level
- All bedrooms are en suite and on the second floor with 9'-4" ceilings
- Interior laundry with stacked washer/dryer and utility sink (2nd floor)
- Stair railings are an industrial-inspired metal and wire system
- Elevator serves all levels

Exterior Details:

- First floor patio with covered hot tub, fire pit station inleuded and space to play games
- Oversized garage with high end epoxy finished flooring has automatic doors, plenty of storage for kayaks & outdoor equipment, could house recreation like a ping pong table
- Rear paver garage driveway can accommodate several cars
- Hardiboard exterior siding
- North (front) yard and side areas are synthetic grass for easy maintenance
- Flood light motion detectors on garage side, dusk-to-dawn detectors on front side
